
Am I saved?

Acts 2:38

"Brothers, what shall we do? Peter replied, 'Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.'"

(Consider these questions from the text, not from personal belief.)

1. The reason for the response of the people.

"Therefore let all Israel be assured of this: God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Messiah." (v.38)

2. The response.

*"When the people heard this, they were **cut to the heart** and said to Peter and the other apostles, 'Brothers, what shall we do?'" (v.37)*

3. Immediate answer from Peter.

"Peter replied, 'Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.'" (v.38)

Why did Peter **not** tell them to believe?

What were the 2 reasons for baptism?

4. What was the immediate results?

Romans 6:3, 4

"Or don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life."

We are baptized into...

We are raised from spiritual death so we may live what kind of life?

Simple question:

Is it possible to be in a room and at the same time go into the same room?

I Peter 3:21

*"...and this water symbolizes baptism **that saves you also**- not the removal of dirt from the body but the pledge of a clear conscience toward God. It saves you by the resurrection of Jesus Christ..."*

Is this talking about real water?

What does **symbolize** mean?

What does **saves you** mean?

What does by **the resurrection of Jesus Christ** mean?

Acts 9:1-17

The conversion of Saul, later called Paul.

Who is Saul, and what did he do?

How did God get Saul's attention?

After Saul had been praying and fasting for three days, who was sent to Paul in Damascus?

Was he saved at this point?

Ananias called Paul his Jewish brother, not his brother in Christ.

What was the message of Ananias?

Paul regained his sight, got up, and was baptized.

Acts 22:12-14

Paul's version of his conversion.

What was Saul's purpose revealed by Ananias?

What did Ananias tell Paul to do to wash away his sins?

Did praying and fasting take his sins away?

In his own words, was Saul saved before he was baptized?
